

WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

“**GDPR**” means the United Kingdom General Data Protection Regulation

“**Policy**” means this website privacy policy.

“**Storegga Group**” means Storegga Limited, its subsidiaries and affiliates, unless specified otherwise.

This website is managed by the **Storegga Group**.

In the spirit of transparency, this Policy details how the **Storegga Group** processes any personal data collected or received when users visit this website.

What information do we collect and how is it used?

When someone visits this website, we collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns using optional cookies. We collect this information in a way which does not identify individuals, and we do not make any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting. We will not associate any data gathered from this site with any personally identifying information from any source. However, the information collected is classed as personal data because a unique identifier is assigned to each visitor. The lawful basis that we rely on to process your personal data when you accept the optional cookies is your consent under Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR. If you contact us via this website, we will use your information to respond to your message. Your message will be relayed to the relevant department who will respond directly to you. We will never share, trade or sell your information to a third-party for marketing purposes. The lawful basis that we rely on for processing your contact details and message is your consent under Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR.

Who has access to data?

Any personal information processed via this website will only be shared internally with Storegga Group personnel and our business partners in relation to relevant projects, if access to that information is necessary for the performance of their roles. Occasionally, we may be required to share information with a competent public authority, government, regulatory or fiscal agency, where it has been deemed necessary to comply with a legal or regulatory obligation. In all circumstances, the data will be subject to confidentiality arrangements.

How do we protect data?

The Storegga Group has implemented a number of operational controls and internal policies to ensure that your data is not lost, accidentally destroyed, misused or disclosed, and is not accessed except by relevant individuals in the performance of their duties. Should any data be transferred outside of the United Kingdom it will be protected by appropriate transfer safeguards, which guarantee an adequate level of data protection

wherever your data is physically kept. When we engage suppliers and partners to process data on our behalf, we do so on the basis of written instructions, ensuring the third-party has implemented appropriate technical and organisational measures to ensure the security of data. In all circumstances, we will ensure that the data is protected and transferred in a manner consistent with applicable data protection laws.

How long do we retain data?

The Storegga Group shall only retain data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purpose for which it was collected before securely deleting it.

Your rights
