SITESELECTION



Following a robust site screening process and review of 40 different locations, including consultation with landowners and other key stakeholders, we selected the site near Ballindalloch - Marypark as our preferred development area for Phases One and Two.

The land is well-suited to host an electrolytic hydrogen project, with favourable features including access to the required area of developable land, good proximity to customers, an electrical grid connection, renewable energy sources, and gas network infrastructure.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

Understanding the potential impact of the development on the proposed site and surrounding area is critical. Ecology, other surveys and studies have been ongoing since 2023 and will continue through this year. This will conclude with an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) that will be submitted along with our planning application.

Such research will help us make informed decisions on the biodiversity present across the proposed site area, so that we can take appropriate mitigation actions within our development plans to minimise any disruption to wildlife habitats or migration processes.
